

Biden and Putin Meeting

To put the upcoming Biden-Putin meeting in perspective we have to look at a couple of things including the 1962 movie and its 2004 remake – **The Manchurian Candidate**.

At the height of the Cold War between the United States and the Soviet Union in 1962, Richard Condon's novel became a movie. The storyline is about the son of a prominent U.S. political family who is brainwashed into being an unwitting assassin for a Communist conspiracy. While the movie was fictional, the Communist Party USA was starting to achieve its goals as described in the *Naked Communist* a book published in 1961. However Biden left his mark, not for any legislative actions, but rather for his embarrassing gaffes, poor jokes, and bizarre responses. Only when Obama reined him in did Biden toll the line. A 2011 Baltimore Sun article said this of Biden, "Joe Biden is Barack Obama's loyal pet, and like even the most loyal dog, he sometimes has an accident on the carpet.
