

# Evil Has Crept In

Whether you are conservative or liberal does not matter. Your country has provided you with certain rights that others want to take from you. While I have written many commentaries over the years, this one may be the most important one concerning your right to your body, mind and soul. Please take the time to read and contemplate its contents.

Ever since Biden became president we have observed the dismantling and destruction of our freedoms, our quality of life, and the downfall of our republic and democratic government. This is **NOT** conjecture but **FACT!**

Evil has crept into our society and government, but it did not start with Biden. It started decades ago, long before Joseph McCarthy and his investigations into communism in the US. Depending upon the resource, some resources believe that the development of socialism in the US can be dated back to the 19<sup>th</sup> century with the development of communal groups such as the Shakers and Amish. Others, however, believe that the socialist movement began when labor activists formed the “Socialist Labor Party of America” in 1877. It should be noted that 29 years prior to its formation, Karl Marx wrote “The Communist Manifesto.”

While the Socialist Party morphed into other organizations, America entered into World War I. Among intense patriotism; anarchist and left-wing social agitation aggravated national, social, and political tensions during the war, and consequently Americans became “hysterical” (Murray Levin, CPUSA) over what was called the “Red Scare,” a Russian a campaign of political repression and executions in which an estimated 2 million people were killed (Russian historian Sergei Volkov).

However the Red Scare did not drive socialism out of the US. Socialists kept working both openly and covertly. While a second Red Scare wave emerged in the 1950s, Americans were falling for subtle social and legal changes.

To understand the socialist (and communist [a socialist branch]) movement we need to recognize that in order to achieve their goals, there must be a “counterculture” movement. The American counterculture movement overtly began in the 1960’s with

the anti-war slogan “Make love, not war.” John Lennon and wife Yoko Ono, who came up with the slogan, were the vanguards of the peace movement. Both were also staunch socialists.

Since the 1960’s, the socialist and communist movements have been aggressively changing all aspects of American life from how the family unit is perceived, to what is taught in our schools and universities, to how businesses need to incorporate so-called new social norms, and how our government and entire justice system no longer upholds the rule of law.

For decades, evil has slowly crept into each of our lives. It did not happen all at once but slowly through the use of repetition. Just like advertising on television and social media, the socialist/communist repetition, relevant to social changes, has caused us to become accustomed to accept things that are unpleasant, unacceptable, or undesirable. Such changes as gays coming out of the closet, defund the police, no cost bail, redefining felony crimes as misdemeanors, redefining American history, etcetera are all examples of how repetition has caused Americans to accept or ignore these changes as commonplace.

In 1775, Patrick Henry, before the House gave a momentous speech that ended with

Like many socialist and communist organizations and supporters, Patrick Henry’s words are taken out of context to support their mantra of freeing “the people” from the tyranny of government. **“Liberty cannot be preserved without a general knowledge among the people, who have a right from the frame of their nature, to knowledge, as their great Creator who does nothing in vain, has given them understandings, and a desire to know”**

John Adams, 1814

Another socialist/communist ploy to subvert our way of life and government is to keep the people ignorant and confused as to what the truth is. While John Adams spoke of this over 200 years ago, along with many others since, we have allowed crisis after

crisis to distract us from what really should be occupying our minds – God, our way of life, and protecting our freedoms.

The iniquity of the far-left, socialists and communists, all of them, represent evil incarnate. This evil uses many techniques and tactics to take control of your mind, will and body. Among these are:

- **Accusations**  
Blaming or accusing others for actions that evil perpetuates. Ex: Biden blaming Trump for the economic woes of our country.
- **Affliction**  
Creates laws, regulations, and other actions that cause pain or suffering. Ex: An Executive Order (EO 14008) that shut down American refineries and put a stop to oil exploration and development. This EO has caused oil and fuel prices to drastically increase, making it burdensome for middle and lower income earners.
- **Conquers**  
For evil to succeed it must take control of the minds and will of the people. Ex: The inclusion of topics as Critical Race Theory (CTR) and similar type subjects in the classroom, and throughout both government and the military.
- **Deceit**  
Deceit is lying, misleading, or otherwise hiding or distorting the truth. Ex: Biden and his administration have been caught in outright lies. They have also misled Americans with regard to climate change and the “Green New Deal” that is being foisted upon Americans by the far left socialists.
- **Hinders**  
Hindrance is the act of creating difficulties for someone or something that results in delays or obstruction. Ex: Increased taxes, government spending, entitlement payments, increased regulations on business and industry and the forfeiting of American energy independence by the Biden and his administration has created roadblocks and walls to the economic development and wellbeing of our nation.
- **Murder**  
The “Bible” commands us not to murder. We have both federal and state laws covering murder and yet, the evil in our nation wants us to go against God’s commandments and murder. Ex: This evil agenda is directly tied to abortion. It is not tied to the death penalty for evil doers even though the leftist, et. al. want to put a stop to death penalty convictions.
- **Perversion**  
Perversion is the alteration of something from its original course, meaning, or state to distort or corrupt what was initially intended. Ex: Under the guise of Climate Change, Biden, the leftists, socialists, and communists want to destroy

our economic wellbeing. Under Trump many economic actions were taken to make our nation independent from relying heavily on other countries, in particular, China and Russia. Through his use of executive orders, Biden cancelled almost all of Trump's actions by altering the course of economic growth. Biden also corrupted many departments and agencies of our government by weaponizing them to go after those who don't agree with the left, socialist and communist agendas.

- **Prompts**

Prompting is the act of suggesting, assisting, encouraging, or persuading someone to do something. It is a cue to take some form of action. Ex: Pro Choice, ShutDownDC, Ruth Sent Us, and other activist and socialist organizations, at the bidding of Biden, illegally protested before the homes of several Supreme Court justices. Prompting is often used to ignite civil unrest such as riots, looting, damaging property, etc.

- **Schemes**

A large-scale systematic plan for attaining a particular goal or putting a particular idea into effect. Creating and implementing schemes to discredit opponents. The leftist, socialists and communists have created schemes to discredit conservative leaders. Ex: The Russian Hoax that was meant to clear Hillary Clinton of wrong-doing, and at the same time, framing Donald Trump for Russian interference in the 2016 elections.

- **Stalks**

The act of pursuing a person, often because of having an unhealthy obsession with them. Ex: There is no better example of stalking as the Democrats obsession to take Trump down and prevent him from running for president. This obsession started prior to the 2016 election and continues today.

- **Steals**

The taking of a person's property without permission or legal right and without intending to return. There are many examples of direct and indirect stealing supported by government. Ex: Biden's Student Debt Forgiveness program will illegally take taxpayer income to pay for the indebtedness that others incurred. Similarly, allowing the egregious influx of illegal migrants into the US and by providing them with access to medical, education, and other benefits, that have not been earned, are illegally paid for by American workers. Also the "tax the rich" agendas espoused by the left, socialists, and communists is nothing more than direct theft of a person earnings and hard work.

- **Tempts**

The enticement or attempt to entice (someone) to do or acquire something that they find attractive but know to be wrong or not beneficial. Closely associated with Prompts and Schemes above, temptations are placed before those willing to

do illegal things. Ex: The providing of masks, clubs, destructive devices to protestors often cause a protest to become a riot. In addition the lack of good and specific oversight into how money is spent often leads to the temptation to steal or misdirect the money. Biden has issued a lot of financial support for various groups without putting sufficient oversight guards in place in order to prevent fraud and misuse.

- **Threatens**

Threats can be implicit or implied. To apply a threat a person or group states their intention to take hostile action against someone for something done or not done. The intent is to harm, in some way, another person or group. Ex: An excellent example was Biden's threat to fire or discharge federal employees or military personnel who refused to get the COVID vaccines. Biden has also consistently threatened the American public that democracy will be destroyed if Republicans took over governing the nation. In 2021, Biden threaten the use of "unprecedented military force against American citizens" to make the case to ban guns.

Among the results of a 2022 national Harris poll, "Fifty-five percent of Americans are more concerned about the "Socialist Left" than they are about "MAGA Republicans." In other words 55% of Americans feel that the Socialist Left is more of a threat to America than Republicans.

These 13 tactics, among others, are used daily by the far left, socialists, and communists to destroy our nation. If you do not believe this, then you are in denial and refuse to open your eyes to the truth. By denying this truth, you have let Satan you're your life. ## Patrick Henry - Give Me Liberty Or Give Me Death

No man thinks more highly than I do of the patriotism, as well as abilities, of the very worthy gentlemen who have just addressed the House. But different men often see the same subject in different lights; and, therefore, I hope it will not be thought disrespectful to those gentlemen if, entertaining as I do opinions of a character very opposite to theirs, I shall speak forth my sentiments freely and without reserve. This is no time for ceremony. The question before the House is one of awful moment to this country. For my own part, I consider it as nothing less than a question of freedom or slavery; and in proportion to the magnitude of the subject ought to be the freedom of the debate. It is only in this way that we can hope to arrive at truth, and fulfill the great responsibility which we hold to God and our country. Should I keep back my opinions at such a time, through fear of giving offense, I should consider myself as guilty of treason towards my country, and of an act of disloyalty toward the Majesty of Heaven, which I revere above all earthly kings.

Mr. President, it is natural to man to indulge in the illusions of hope. We are apt to shut our eyes against a painful truth, and listen to the song of that siren till she transforms us into beasts. Is this the part of wise men, engaged in a great and arduous struggle for liberty? Are we disposed to be of the number of those who, having eyes, see not, and, having ears, hear not, the things which so nearly concern their temporal salvation? For my part, whatever anguish of spirit it may cost, I am willing to know the whole truth; to know the worst, and to provide for it.

I have but one lamp by which my feet are guided, and that is the lamp of experience. I know of no way of judging of the future but by the past. And judging by the past, I wish to know what there has been in the conduct of the British ministry for the last ten years to justify those hopes with which gentlemen have been pleased to solace themselves and the House. Is it that insidious smile with which our petition has been lately received?

Trust it not, sir; it will prove a snare to your feet. Suffer not yourselves to be betrayed with a kiss. Ask yourselves how this gracious reception of our petition comports with those warlike preparations which cover our waters and darken our land. Are fleets and armies necessary to a work of love and reconciliation? Have we shown ourselves so unwilling to be reconciled that force must be called in to win back our love? Let us not deceive ourselves, sir. These are the implements of war and subjugation; the last arguments to which kings resort. I ask gentlemen, sir, what means this martial array, if its purpose be not to force us to submission? Can gentlemen assign any other possible motive for it? Has Great Britain any enemy, in this quarter of the world, to call for all this accumulation of navies and armies? No, sir, she has none. They are meant for us: they can be meant for no other. They are sent over to bind and rivet upon us

those chains which the British ministry have been so long forging. And what have we to oppose to them? Shall we try argument? Sir, we have been trying that for the last ten years. Have we anything new to offer upon the subject? Nothing. We have held the subject up in every light of which it is capable; but it has been all in vain. Shall we resort to entreaty and humble supplication? What terms shall we find which have not been already exhausted? Let us not, I beseech you, sir, deceive ourselves.

Sir, we have done everything that could be done to avert the storm which is now coming on. We have petitioned; we have remonstrated; we have supplicated; we have prostrated ourselves before the throne, and have implored its interposition to arrest the tyrannical hands of the ministry and Parliament. Our petitions have been slighted; our remonstrances have produced additional violence and insult; our supplications have been disregarded; and we have been spurned, with contempt, from the foot of the throne! In vain, after these things, may we indulge the fond hope of peace and reconciliation. There is no longer any room for hope. If we wish to be free-- if we mean to preserve inviolate those inestimable privileges for which we have been so long contending--if we mean not basely to abandon the noble struggle in which we have been so long engaged, and which we have pledged ourselves never to abandon until the glorious object of our contest shall be obtained--we must fight! I repeat it, sir, we must fight! An appeal to arms and to the God of hosts is all that is left us!

They tell us, sir, that we are weak; unable to cope with so formidable an adversary. But when shall we be stronger? Will it be the next week, or the next year? Will it be when we are totally disarmed, and when a British guard shall be stationed in every house? Shall we gather strength by irresolution and inaction? Shall we acquire the means of effectual resistance by lying supinely on our backs and hugging the delusive phantom of hope, until our enemies shall have bound us hand and foot? Sir, we are not weak if we make a proper use of those means which the God of nature hath placed in our power. The millions of people, armed in the holy cause of liberty, and in such a country as that which we possess, are invincible by any force which our enemy can send against us. Besides, sir, we shall not fight our battles alone. There is a just God who presides over the destinies of nations, and who will raise up friends to fight our battles for us. The battle, sir, is not to the strong alone; it is to the vigilant, the active, the brave. Besides, sir, we have no election. If we were base enough to desire it, it is now too late to retire from the contest. There is no retreat but in submission and slavery! Our chains are forged! Their clanking may be heard on the plains of Boston! The war is inevitable--and let it come! I repeat it, sir, let it come.

It is in vain, sir, to extenuate the matter. Gentlemen may cry, Peace, Peace-- but there is no peace. The war is actually begun!
